Mandatory equipment

A visual guide from Speed Skating Canada is attached. Please review it before the skate fitting.

The items in **bold** are available to borrow for the Learn to Speed Skate program and for purchase for the regular season. These items can be obtained through the club during skate fittings and throughout the season.

- clothing with long sleeves and long pants or **speed skating suit**
 - intermediate and senior skaters should consider a **cut-proof suit**.
These can be ordered through the club.
- **speed skating helmet**, downhill skiing or hockey helmet; biking helmets are not permitted.
- **safety glasses with straps to hold them snug on the head**
- neck guard with bib
- thick gloves or mittens (more advanced skaters should consider purchasing **leather gloves**)
- knee pads
- **shin guards**
- **Kevlar ankle guards**
